

**Criteria for Initial Granting of Cervicocerebral Angiography Privileges
Gulf Coast Medical Center**

1. Applicants will be members of the active or associate medical staff or in the process of applying for such membership.
2. Physicians should be qualified in basic cervicocerebral angiography.
3. Physicians will have:
 - A. completed a residency or fellowship with specific training in neuroradiology and/or interventional radiology, defined as six month of diagnostic and interventional training in neuroradiology and interventional radiology to include cervicocerebral angiography; **OR**
 - B. demonstration of two years of experience under the supervision of an on-site, qualified physician during which time at least 80 cervical-cerebral angiographic procedures were performed with documented success and acceptable complication rates.
4. Applicants may be requested to submit case/procedure logs, a letter from the director of a training program, a letter of reference from a physician who has knowledge of the training and/or experience, and/or additional documentation, as requested.
