

EMERGENCY MEDICINE CRITERIA

Gulf Coast Medical Center

Department of Medicine

Applicants **initially applying** for emergency medicine privileges must be able to demonstrate the following criteria:

1. Residency trained, ABEM (American Board of Emergency Medicine) or AOBEM (American Osteopathic Board of Emergency Medicine) board certified or eligible;

or
2. Board certification in emergency medicine by AAPS (American Association of Physician Specialties); or
3. Full-time Emergency Medicine physician that meets criteria for AAPS boards:
 - A. AAPS board eligibility requirements; and
 - B. Board certification in primary care; and
 - C. 5 years and 7,000 hours of emergency medicine experience; and
 - D. ACLS, ATLS and PALS certification.
