<b>CATEGORY I</b> ( <i>Direct Supervision – The physical presence of the supervising physician on the premises to ensure immediate availability</i> ):			
<b>General:</b> Intravenous agents, inhalation agents, intramuscular agents <b>Regional:</b> Spinal (including continuous), caudal, intravenous, upper extremity blocks, lower extremity blocks, field blocks <b>Procedures:</b> Placement of central venous lines, autotransfusion techniques, hypotensive techniques, hypertensive techniques, hypothermia			
<b>CATEGORY II</b> ( <i>Indirect Supervision – Easy availability of the supervising physician, including the physician’s reasonable physical proximity and availability to communicate by telephone</i> ):			
<b>General:</b> Pre-anesthesia interview/physical assessment, pre-operative preparation and medication, write post-op orders (physician countersigns), post-anesthesia evaluation <b>Regional:</b> Topical, infiltration, epidural <b>Procedures:</b> intravenous catheter placement, intravenous administration of (fluids, blood, plasma, plasma expanders, muscle relaxants, vasoactive drugs, cardiac drugs), endotracheal intubation, placement of arterial lines, mechanical ventilation, resuscitation techniques and therapy			
<b>CATEGORY III</b> ( <i>Sedation Analgesia</i> )			
Applicants must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Provide evidence of successful completion of CRNA program; &amp;</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Have current certification in ACLS.</li> </ul> <p><b>Minimal Sedation</b> (A drug-induced state during which patient responds normally to verbal commands. Although cognitive function and coordination may be impaired, ventilatory and cardiovascular functions are unaffected. This includes patients who receive low doses of sedatives/opioids for the purpose of pain or anxiety control.)</p> <p><b>Moderate Sedation</b> (Conscious sedation is a drug-induced state during which patients respond normally to verbal commands. No interventions are required to maintain a patent airway and spontaneous ventilation is adequate. Cardiovascular functions usually maintained.)</p> <p><b>Deep Sedation/Analgesia</b> (A drug-induced depression of consciousness during which patients cannot be easily aroused but respond purposefully following repeated or painful stimulation. The ability to independently maintain ventilatory function may be impaired. Patients may require assistance in maintaining a patent airway and ventilation may be inadequate. Cardiovascular function is usually maintained.)</p>
